Tigran Tovmasyan is a senior specialist in international education and humanitarian action with over 20 years of professional experience in education, disaster risk reduction for resilience, climate change and emergency preparedness and response.

He is providing high-level strategic advice and working with governments at the local and national levels on disaster risk

reduction and climate change adaptation, policy and curriculum development, inclusive education, education for democratic citizenship.

Currently, he works as an Emergency Specialist for the UNICEF Regional Office in Europe and Central Asia since 2020 to support the advancement of risk-informed programming and child-centred disaster preparedness, disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation in Europe and Central Asia.

From 2010 to 2020 he worked for UNICEF Country Office in Armenia as a Disaster Risk Reduction Programme Officer and supported the enhancement of national legislation, monitoring and coordination, and sub-national capacities for risk informed child and gender-sensitive disaster and climate risk reduction and enhanced the participation of children and adolescent girls and boys in resilience-building, disaster risk reduction, climate change adaptation and environmental sustainability initiatives through the use innovative technology, 21st century skills and volunteer opportunities.

Tigran holds a Master of Education in International Education from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst, USA and a Specialist with Diploma, Higher Education Diploma with Honor in Applied Mathematics from Yerevan State University, Yerevan, Armenia.
