HOP nurtures confident, curious learners who think boldly and thrive in every environment.



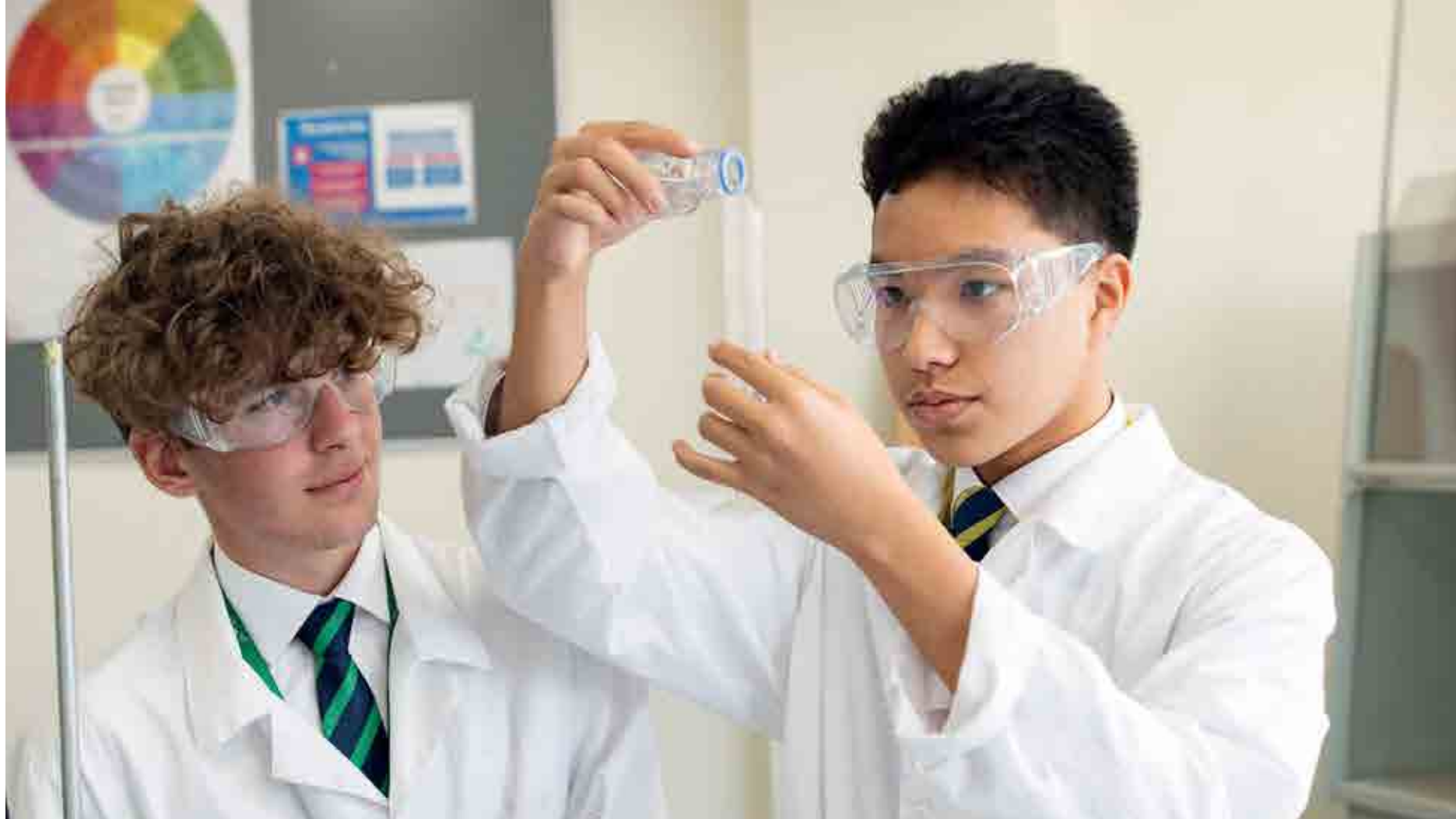
We proudly integrate Kazakh language, traditions, and cultural values into daily school life, creating a distinctive balance between national identity and world-class international education.

At Haileybury Almaty we offer a wide range of sporting activities for pupils at all ages and stages of development.



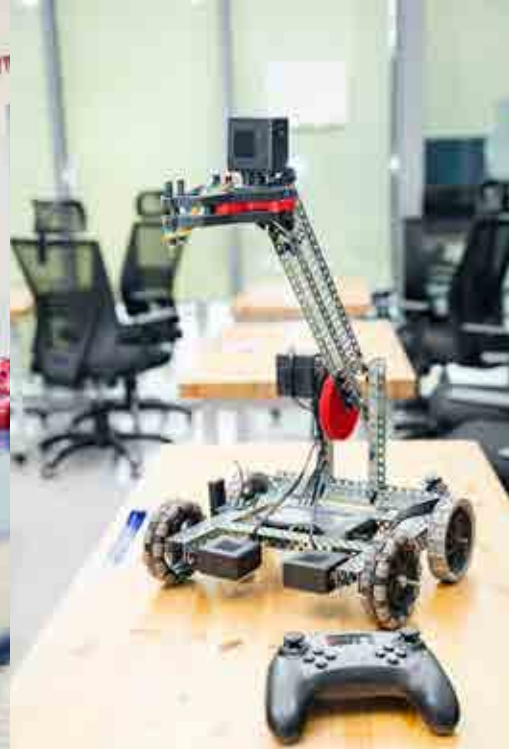

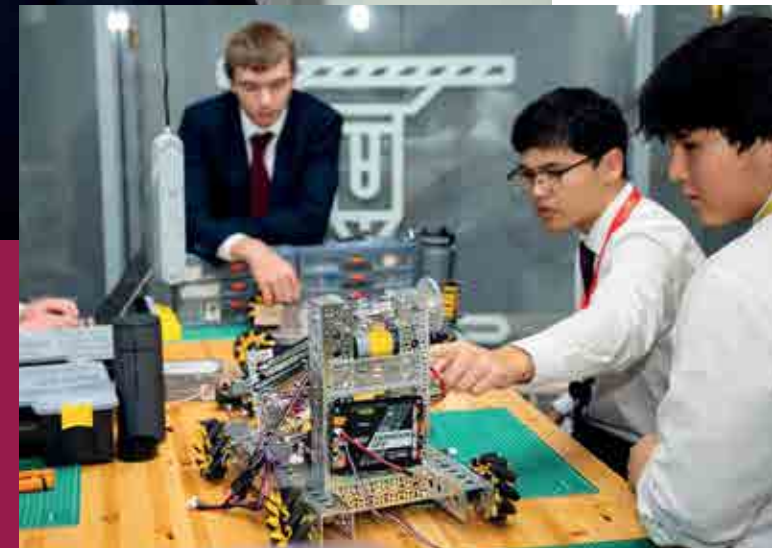


Maker Space and Robotics Lab
